INDEPENDENT VERIFICATION AND CERTIFICATION

PILA's goal posts have been independently tested and certified compliant to Australian Standard AS EN 16579:2020 for the Product Safety Unit Office of Fair Trading Employment and Industry Development; Department of Employment, Economic Development, and Innovation. The testing was professionally recorded on camera for verification and the scales used were independently calibrated by the University of Technology, Sydney NSW.

WARNING

A manufacturer supplying a Moveable Goal Post Certificate of Compliance must be able to provide independent and verified Australian test results for the certificate of compliance to be valid.

Buyer Beware: Some imported moveable goal posts currently sold in Australia have not been independently tested and are supplied with unverified compliance certificates. The wording on those documents is often simply a copy of the wording on this original PILA Certificate of Compliance document. Buyers should seek immediate advice from the ACCC if a supplier is selling moveable goal posts in Australia and they cannot provide proof of independent testing documentation and verification of certification to the mandatory Australian Standard.
